

**CLOVERDALE TOWN COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 18, 2026**

The Cloverdale Town Council met in Special Session at 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 18, 2026, in the Town Hall; 154 S. Main Street; Cloverdale, IN 46120. The purpose of this meeting was to elect new officers due to the recent resignation of Brandon Tancak and Brice Howell.

CALL TO ORDER: In the absence of both President and Vice President, Clerk Treasurer Kelly Maners called the meeting to order at 5:34 p.m.

PLEDGE TO THE FLAG: The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

ROLL CALL: Present on Roll Call were Councilmembers Larry Fidler, Greg Jay and Scott Stierwalt. Also present were Town Attorney Richard Shagley, Town Manager Jason Hartman, Town Marshal Adam Hull and Clerk Treasurer Kelly Maners.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS:

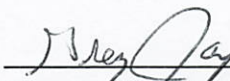
PRESIDENT: Clerk Treasurer Maners called for nominations for President. Councilmember Fidler nominated Greg Jay. Councilmember Jay seconded the nomination. There were no other nominations. The vote was 2-1 in favor of Councilmember Jay as President. Councilmember Stierwalt was the dissenting vote.

Since there were presently only 3 members on the Council, questions arose as to how many votes were needed to elect the officers. The meeting was recessed at 5:37 for Town Attorney Shagley to review the law on this matter.

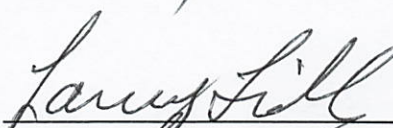
The meeting was reconvened at 5:44. Attorney Shagley stated the Town's governing documents state the Town follows Roberts Rules of Order. He further stated Roberts Rules of Order say, in the case of 2 vacancies on the Council a 2-1 vote was enough to pass. The gavel was dropped and passed to Greg Jay who became the President of the Town Council.

VICE PRESIDENT: President Jay called for nominations for Vice President. Councilmember Stierwalt nominated himself. There was not a second. President Jay called for any other nominations. Councilmember Fidler nominated himself. Discussion ensued as to whether the President could second a nomination. Attorney Shagley stated he was permitted to second a nomination. President Jay seconded Larry Fidler's nomination. The vote was 2-1 in favor of Larry Fidler as Vice President. Councilmember Stierwalt was the dissenting vote. Larry Fidler is Vice President of the Town Council.

ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned by President Jay at 5:47 p.m.
